POLICIES, BYLAWS & RESOLUTIONS

POLICY	DEFINITION	VOTES REQUIRED
AJLI Certificate of Incorporation	Legal document establishing the corporation.	Two-thirds of the Junior Leagues required to adopt or amend.
AJLI Bylaws	Organizational document that spells out the governance and regulation of AJLI's affairs; stipulates who the members of AJLI are, what authority Leagues have and what authority Leagues delegate to the Board.	Two-thirds of the Junior Leagues required to adopt or amend.
<i>Operational Policies Approved by the Junior Leagues</i>	Statements, based on the Bylaws, that spell out those aspects of AJLI that directly impact the programs, operations and activities of the Junior Leagues.	Two-thirds affirmative vote of the votes cast by Junior Leagues required to adopt or amend.
Advisory Resolutions	Resolutions that communicate areas of interest, concern or grievance by member Junior League(s) to the AJLI Board of Directors. These resolutions are advisory in nature and suggest possible action to the Board.	Majority affirmative vote (of all votes cast) required to adopt or amend.
AJLI External Policies	Statements adopted by the Junior Leagues expressing their shared values on public policy issues. An External Policy is required before any collective action may be taken on behalf of all Junior Leagues; at present there are no AJLI External Policies.	85% affirmative vote of the votes cast by Junior Leagues required to adopt or amend.
Association Governance Dialogue	An opportunity for informal dialogue and discussion of any governance or owner matter of interest to the Junior Leagues regarding the Association.	Dialogue is an informal session at which no formal votes are taken.
AJLI Board-Approved Operational Policies	Statements, based on the Bylaws, that spell out how the Board governs and manages AJLI.	Majority vote of the Board required to adopt or amend.
